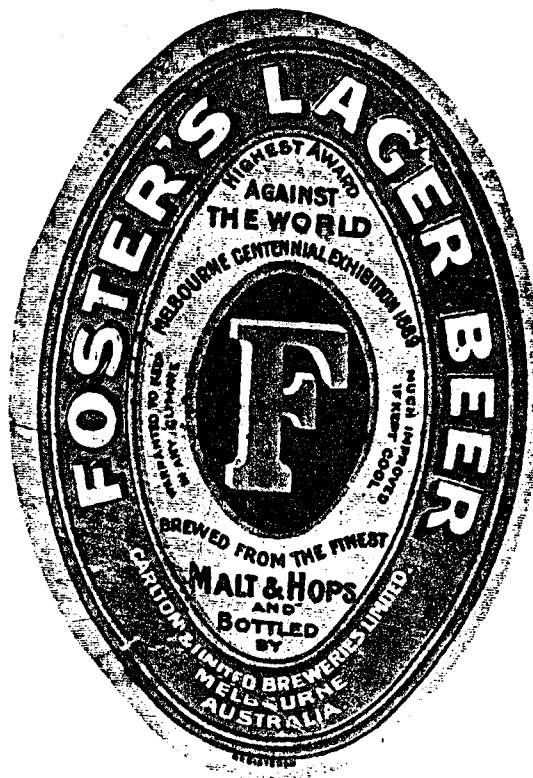
## LABELS ISSUED
